SACRAMENTS & PARISH SUPPORT

Baptism: Holy Baptism is the basis of the whole Christian life, the gateway to life in the Spirit, and the door which gives access to the other sacraments. There are three steps required for Parents to complete: registration, submitting the required documents and booking the date. This is all done online through our webpage www.stalbertthegreat.ca/baptisminfo

First Reconciliation & First Eucharist: In Grades 2 and up, children who are baptized are invited to the Lord's Table to partake in this banquet by receiving Jesus in First Eucharist. The children make themselves ready to receive our Lord by first preparing for and receiving First Reconciliation. Registration for First Reconciliation & First Eucharist for the 2024-2025 school year is now closed. Please email sacraments@stalbertthegreat.ca for more information.

Confirmation: In Grade 6 and up, youth are called to be witnesses of Christ's love to the world as they receive the fullness of the gifts of the Holy Spirit in Confirmation. Registration is still open! Visit www.stalbertthegreat.ca/confirmation-main for the dates and registration form.

Marriage: To arrange a marriage at St. Albert the Great, six to nine months' notice is required. *Couples who are planning a wedding in the parish are expected to regularly worship with a Catholic Community and participate in a Marriage Preparation Program.* Please contact the office at [403.257.6054](tel:403.257.6054) to arrange an appointment with the priest.

Declaration of nullity (annulments): An annulment (formally known as a "declaration of nullity") is a ruling that a particular marriage was null from the beginning—that is, something was gravely wrong at the time the wedding vows were made, and it prevented a valid marriage from coming into existence. This is different than a divorce, which proposes to dissolve a marriage that is in existence. When a man and woman have divorced, they can contact the appropriate diocese to have the process of annulment started. **Please contact: Fr. Becoming Catholic: Many adults entering the Catholic Church, or those just thinking about it, follow a process known as **RCIA** — the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults. RCIA is a journey of conversion within the living community of faith. It is designed to educate converts in the Catholic faith and prepare them to receive the sacraments of the Catholic Church. The RCIA inquiry stage is the starting place for teens & adults who are thinking about entering the Catholic Church.
