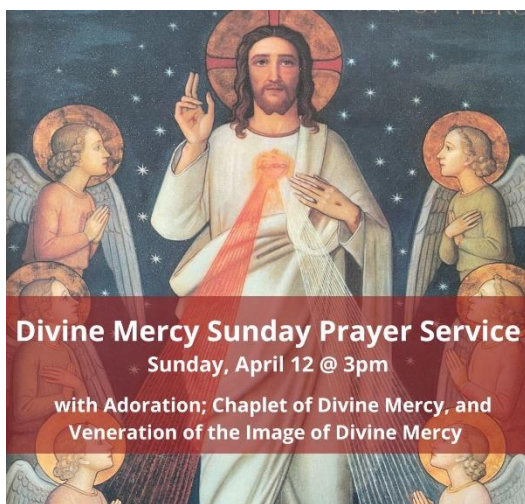

### **Divine Mercy Sunday 3pm Prayer Service**

Join us on Sunday, April 12th at 3pm for a prayer service to celebrate the Feast of Divine Mercy. There will be a Reflection, Adoration, veneration of the Divine Mercy Image, and singing of the Chaplet of Divine Mercy. Our Lord's promise to grant complete forgiveness of sins and punishment on the Feast of Mercy is recorded in the *Diary of St. Maria Faustina Kowalska*: **"I want to grant a complete pardon to the souls that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion on the Feast of My Mercy." (1109)**

How to prepare for the Feast:

1. Go to confession prior to the Feast day.
2. Receive Holy Communion on the day of the Feast (or the vigil).
3. Perform works of mercy through actions, words and prayers.
4. Pray the Novena to Divine Mercy, which begins on Good Friday, and can be found here: [Divine Mercy Novena](#).
5. Place your complete trust in Jesus!

Beginning May 2-3 our new Mass times will be:

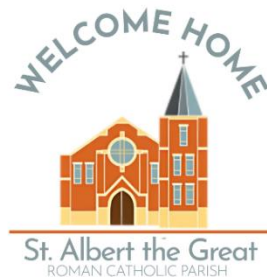
**Saturday: 5:00 pm**
