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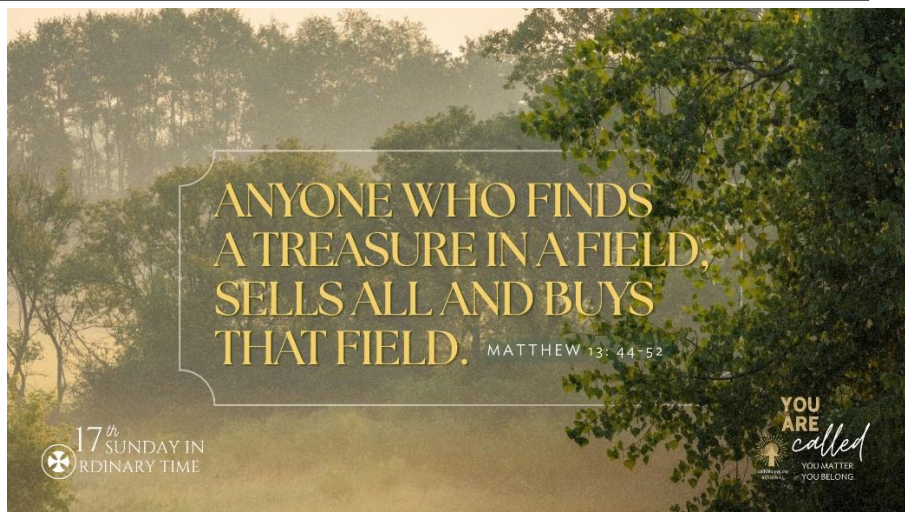

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TODAY'S READINGS

[Romans 8:28-30](#) | [Matthew 13:44-52](#)



The stewardship way of life could be described as a daily pursuit of the Kingdom of Heaven. In today's Gospel from Matthew, Jesus uses a series of parables to help us understand the incomparable value of that Kingdom.

First, He reminds us that living for Him and for His Kingdom will require sacrifice. Yet the joy that comes from following Christ makes any sacrifice worthwhile. Jesus says, "The kingdom of heaven is like a treasure buried in a field, which a person finds and hides again, and out of joy goes and sells all that he has and buys that field." He then compares the Kingdom to "a merchant searching for fine pearls." When the merchant finds a pearl of great price, he gladly sells everything he has to obtain it.

In both parables, the Kingdom is something precious that must be sought and recognized. We must intentionally look for it amid the distractions and noise of the world.

Yet Jesus also reminds us that the Kingdom is meant for everyone. He compares it to a net cast into the sea that gathers fish of every kind.

At the same time, He reminds us that each of us will one day be judged. The angels "will separate the wicked from the righteous." It is a powerful reminder that our choices matter.

Let us pray for the wisdom to recognize the Kingdom of Heaven in our midst and to pursue it above all else. There is no greater treasure, and no greater source of joy, than a life lived as a faithful disciple of Jesus.

Parking for a Mass: We are hearing more and more feedback from our neighbours questioning why so many people attending a Mass at our church park on the street rather than in our parking lot. This is an issue for those attending both weekday and weekend Masses.

While street parking is a public resource, residents use it for themselves and their guests along with community members who use it to attend the community park across the street from the church. There is no reason for our Parishioners to park on the street when we have a large parking lot with over 270 parking stalls, which is rarely full.

We ask that everyone please help us be good neighbours and leave the street parking for the residents. Our parking lot is for the use of our Parishioners and it should be your first choice when attending Mass both on the weekend and during the week.

When attending a weekend Mass, please also respect the drop-off and pick-up zone in front of the church. It is designed to accommodate two vehicles so as to allow for the free-flow of traffic. When one of the orange pylons is moved to allow for a car to park, it defeats the intended purpose of the zone.

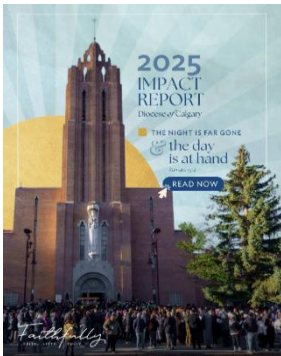
